

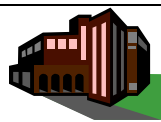
## A. B.etter Choice to College Preparation

## CURRENT WORKSHOP COURSES

**Consultation/Orientation 099 (1 hr)** – One hour session is designed to meet with student and parent(s) to discuss the program offerings, to ascertain any information about the student desires to attend college, academic-career goals, and to provide recommendations for workshop courses. This session is available as a one-on-one session only (\$40).



**Black College Prep 101 (2hrs)** – Session is designed to prepare parents and students to participate meaningfully and successfully in attaining admission to a post secondary educational program at an Historically Black College or University (HBCU). Discussion includes pondering questions: Majority vs. Minority, Educational Goals-What's Right For Me, UNCF 101, and the 25 Things that Make the HBCU Experience Unforgettable.

**The College Prep Timeline 201 (2hrs)** – Session will assist with making students aware of the recommended steps to be completed throughout a student's high school career to prepare for college. Topics include college application, essay package, meeting deadlines, developing a college road map, the College Comparison Worksheet and the Personal Data Sheet.



**Show Me the Money 301 (2hrs)** – Session is designed to provide participants with an understanding of applying for federal aid, developing an efficient strategy for finding scholarships, and completing the scholarship application. Time will be allotted to reviewing the different types of federal loan programs. Topics include what happens during the application process, completing the FAFSA, and the Financial Aid Package (Comparison) Worksheet.

**Don't Sell yourself Cheap 401 (2hrs)** – Session is designed for students to gain proficiency in writing scholarship resumes and essays. Topics such as what goes into a resume and how to make an essay stand out will be discussed. Various resume samples and templates will be reviewed to analyze the techniques, methods and approaches that are effective in the application process.

- Each workshop includes handouts and activities to engage the student/parent in a meaningful understanding of the session.
